Forums were founded to integrate Local Government and local development systems. They were established as part of the County/City Development Board process to facilitate consultation with the Community and Voluntary sector. County/City Fora (34 in total) were founded in 2000. The Irish National Community & Voluntary Forum (INCVF) is their national representative body and was established in November 2003.

- Membership is open to all community and voluntary groups.
- Individuals and/or elected representatives are not entitled to membership.

As a National Forum our role and function include:

- To act as a representative voice for Fora countrywide.
- To act as an information conduit on models of best practice and to disseminate information on innovative ideas.
- To foster a clear understanding of the objectives laid out in the legislation for the establishment of County/City Forums and to promote the need for Social Inclusion in policy decisions at this level.
- To support individual County/City Forums to resolve problems that arise in the execution of their duties and responsibilities and to resolve difficulties that arise at county/city level.
- To encourage the pooling of resources to avoid duplication at County/City Forum level (shared learning).
- To establish at national level links and arrangements that will benefit all County/City Forums and their member groups.
- To be non-political, non-denominational and non-discriminatory.
- To nominate representatives of the C&V Sector to statutory bodies, state agencies, voluntary agencies/bodies as requested at National level.
