

VOTE for the City You Want

**Irish Local Elections
5th June 2009**

**The final deadline to Register to
Vote is Monday 18th May 2009**

Regardless of your status in Ireland, if you are over 18 years of age by 15th Feb 2009 you are eligible to VOTE in local elections, so make sure you are on the register to vote.

FOR INFORMATION ON HOW TO REGISTER TO VOTE OR CHECK THAT YOU ARE LISTED ON THE REGISTER CORRECTLY

To put yourself on the voting register you must fill in the supplementary voter registration form (RFA2) and submit it by Monday 18th May 2009. This must be stamped at a local Garda Station or by another Registration Authority Official (as explained on the form).

These forms are available online at www.dublincity.ie or www.checktheregister.ie and at Post Offices, Libraries, Garda Stations or Dublin City Council Offices.

If you have already registered and want to check that you are listed with the correct information go online to www.checktheregister.ie. If you are on the register but you have moved address you must complete the application form (RFA3). If you have questions about how your other details are listed on the register and want to amend them please contact the Dublin City Franchise Section. If your details do not appear on the register then you must complete an application form (RFA2) for inclusion in the supplement.
